NATURE OF INCIDENT: MISSING PERSON

DATE/TIME OF INCIDENT: 11-04-2025 AT 1245

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: 30 S 21 1/2 RD IN BOON TOWNSHIP OF WEXFORD COUNTY

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

Rebecca Park is still considered a Missing Person who may be Endangered after she is alleged to have voluntarily gotten into a vehicle, she is reported to have arranged to pick her up, on Monday November 3rd, 2025 at approximately 2030.

The Sheriff's Office and the Michigan State Police are still actively working to locate Rebecca. Extensive searches of the area where Park was last seen have been conducted by law enforcement and later volunteers. No additional evidence was located in either search.

A new volunteer group is apparently in that area, calling themselves a "Recovery team." This group was not requested by the Sheriff's Office; they are strictly volunteering to search for Rebecca. We did agree they're free to do so but are not working under the authority of our agency.

There is presently no known direct evidence that Park has been the victim of an assault. For example, police are not in possession of bloody clothing as someone has suggested.

The status of her pregnancy is unknown.

MisInformation and vitriol circulating on social media has and continues to hamper this investigation. Despite rumors circulating on the internet, Law Enforcement has not declared that this is a search for human remains.

Due to the negative impact social media is having, we are unable to share information pertaining to the ongoing efforts to find Rebecca. Please do not tie police resources up by calling to ask for such details.

If you know where Rebecca Park can be located, please call 911.

Due to the volume of calls, a tip line has now been established for actionable information regarding Rebecca Park. If you would like to leave a tip, please call 231-306-2072. Again, if you are calling to ask questions, information is not currently being shared.

When there is any significant change in this case, the Sheriff's Office will make an updated press release. Until such time, please use good Judgement and common sense about what you see, hear, read or post on social media. Our efforts to locate Rebecca will continue until she is found. If you don't see a press release from our agency, trust that there has been no significant change, despite what anyone else may say.
